EUROPEAN PATENT ATTORNEYS - EUROPEAN TRADE MARK AND DESIGN ATTORNEYS

I. PATENTS

- 1. Power of Attorney (no legalization required).
- 2. Specification and claims to be translated.
- 3. Abstract of maximum 150 words.
- 4. Two sets of formal drawings (A4), clear black lines on white paper, minimum top margin 2.5 cm, left 2.5 cm, right 1.5 cm, bottom 1 cm.

II. TRADE/SERVICE MARKS

- 1. Power of attorney (no legalization required).
- 2. List of goods and/or services, classified in accordance with International Classification.
- 3. If a mark is other than a word in block lettering, 6 black and white prints of max. 8 x 8 cm. If a mark is in colour, 6 colour specimens.
- 4. For collective marks, a general instrument governing the grant of the right to use the collective mark.

III. DESIGNS

- 1. Power of attorney (no legalization required).
- 2. Three sets of photographs (max. 16 x 16 cm, black and white, of professional quality) or formal drawings (A4, suitable for reproduction, preferably in perspective view).

IV. NATIONAL PHASE OF A PCT APPLICATION

Not available any more for the applications filed after 1 December 2002Only EP route is possible

V. VALIDATION OF A EUROPEAN PATENT

- 1. Power of attorney (no legalization required).
- 2. Copy of the text as granted (a translation of the *claims only* has to be filed within three months as of the date of mention of grant in European Bulletin).
